NEW DELHI: Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader BS Yeddyurappa will take oath as Karnataka Chief Minister today morning after the Supreme Court in a late night-early morning hearing on Thursday declined to order a stay on his swearing-in ceremony. The apex court took up the joint petition by the Congress-Janata Dal-Secular alliance at around 1:45 am on Thursday and it was only the second time in its history that the SC had opened its doors for a hearing. Here are the top developments on Karnataka: - Three judges of the Supreme Court heard the petition in an unprecedented late-night hearing on Thursday but refused to stay the oath-taking ceremony.
In its order, the apex court said that the Governor's decision cannot be overruled since it is a constitutional authority. - The apex court ruling implies that BJP leader BS Yeddyurappa will chair the apex court hearing on the apex court also scheduled today, as scheduled.

Supreme Court ruling

The lending rate under the MIF has been proposed at three per cent lower than the cost of raising the fund by NABARD, an official statement said. The dedicated fund would supplement the efforts of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) and help bring about 10 lakh hectares under micro-irrigation, it added. For the current fiscal, Rs 2,000 crore has been allocated, while Rs 3,000 crore has been earmarked for 2019-20. The fund will facilitate states to mobilise resources for their initiatives, including additional (top up subsidy) in implementation of PMKSY-PDMC to achieve the annual target of about two million hectares per year during the remaining period of 14th Finance Commission. The states can access this fund for innovative integrated projects, including projects in the public private partnership (PPP) mode and also for incentivizing micro-irrigation. In another decision, the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA), chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi, doubled the budget for laying an alternative communications network for defence services to Rs 24,664 crore.

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
