

# Eastern express kills more Two die as road divider



Two young men died early on Saturday morning after they crashed their motorbike into iron barricades that were put up for road diversions on the Eastern Express Highway (EEH) at Chunabhatti. The victims have been identified as Chetan Shelar, 26, and Rahul Kadam, 27. This is the fourth accident that has claimed lives on the EEH, the highway that connects the island city to the eastern suburbs and Thane, in the last two months alone.

to Chunabhatti. Shelar was riding a motorcycle and Kadam was seated in the pillion seat. The accident occurred at around 1.45 p.m. on a south-bound lane of the highway near Chunabhatti. Police said they had failed to stop the barricades and the motorbike into them. Kadam were taken to a nearby hospital where they succumbed to injuries. "The victims were put up for

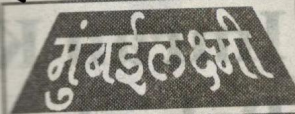
